

Situation escalated to such an extent that the security personnel were compelled to open the gates after prolonged protest by the waiting guardians.

It is pertinent to mention that verification of signatures and other mandatory checks relating to the OMR answer sheets are required to be completed **during the examination period itself** and not after the examination has concluded. Such avoidable mismanagement created an unprecedented situation at the examination centre and reflected poorly on the administration. Incidents of this nature directly affect the public image and credibility of our Department.

It is indeed unfortunate that this Union is compelled to raise similar concerns after almost every departmental examination. The recurrence of issues relating to question papers, examination management, and administrative lapses suggests that these problems are gradually becoming a routine feature of examinations conducted in our Circle. Such a situation is neither desirable nor acceptable, particularly when these examinations have a direct bearing on the career progression and future prospects of departmental employees.

In view of the foregoing facts, this Union most respectfully requests your kind office to:

(1) Examine the enclosed representations regarding the out-of-syllabus questions in Paper-I and Paper-II.

(2) Take appropriate corrective measures, including awarding suitable relief to the affected candidates, if the representations are found to be valid.

(3) Conduct an inquiry into the administrative lapses reported at the HariyanaVidyamandir Examination Centre and take suitable action to prevent recurrence of such incidents.

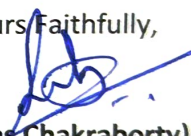
(4) Put in place an effective mechanism to ensure that future LDCE/CE question papers are prepared strictly in accordance with the prescribed syllabus and that examinations are conducted in a fair, transparent, and professionally managed manner.

This Union sincerely hopes that the issues highlighted above will receive your kind and immediate consideration so that the interests of the candidates are protected and confidence in the departmental examination system is restored.
